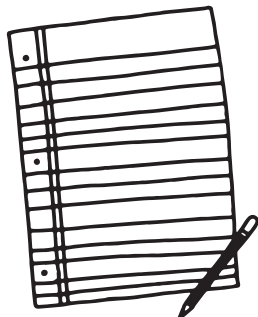


# STORYTELLING ADVENTURES

## Things to Write

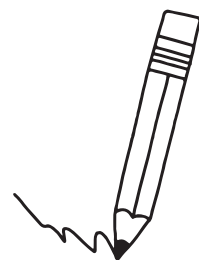


### STARRING YOU!

Open a book. Use any sentence as your first line.



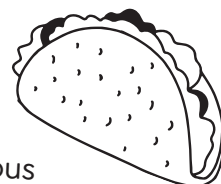
### WHAT DO YOU SEE?

### TASTY POETRY

Write an acrostic poem about your favorite food.



For example:

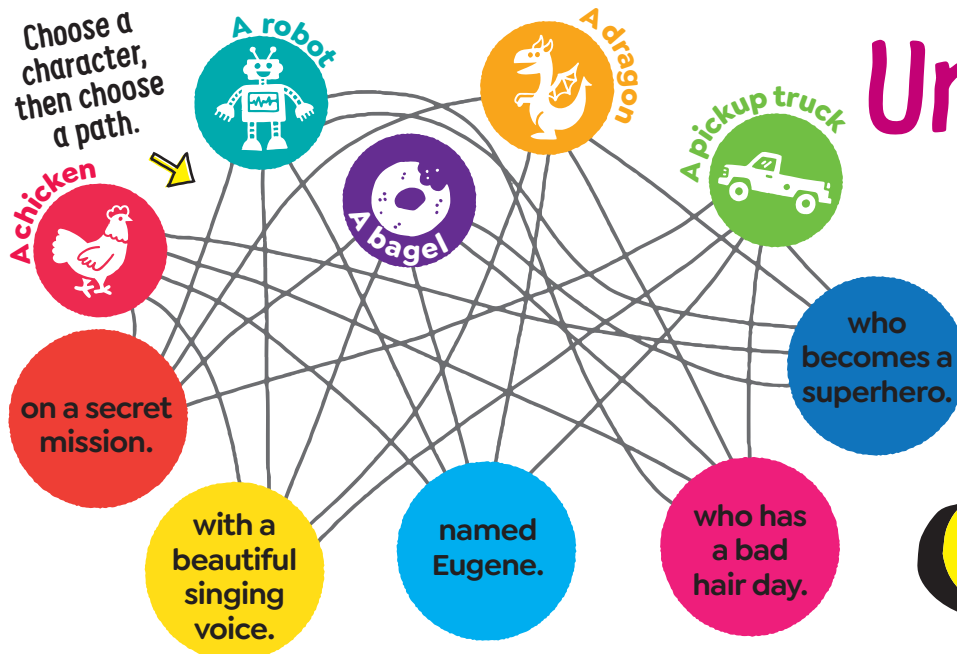
**T**ortilla shell
